

Greetings from The Monster Mile!

Congratulations on your purchase of the **Ultimate Fan Pass** at Dover Motor Speedway! We look forward to seeing you soon for this exclusive behind-the-scenes opportunity as part of NASCAR All-Star Weekend on **May 17**.

We've got a lot to explain to you, and we want to make sure you have all the information you need to ensure your Monster Mile experience is a memorable one.

RACE WEEKEND CONTACT INFO

PICKUP LOCATION AND TIMES

Everything you'll need for your Ultimate Fan Pass experience will be available for pickup at the **Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials Office**, located just off the Speedway's main entrance, at the following times:

- **Friday, May 15:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Saturday, May 16:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Sunday, May 17:** 8 a.m. to Noon

When you arrive, you'll receive:

- Your UFP credential & lanyard
- Your Garage & Pit Road pass
- JLab gift

Your Garage & Pit Road pass will be ready for you to retrieve at the same time you collect your JLab gift and lanyard – all at the Dover Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials office.

GETTING AROUND & SCHEDULE

Because you already have your tickets to the race on your mobile phone, you will park wherever you choose (\$20 fee on-site) and head to the track. If you've been to a NASCAR event you know that these large venues require a good amount of walking. We encourage you to wear comfortable shoes, layer your clothes in case you get hot or cold, bring sunscreen and make sure there is plenty of space available on your phone for photos!

You can always enter and exit the track via Gate 12, outside of Turn 2 of the Speedway, by walking over the pedestrian crossover bridge. *(Note that the Gate 12 entrance requires you to climb stairs to get inside the track).* That said, if your seats or parking are located on the other side of the property, it might be preferable to use the Gate 1 entrance in the morning. Just know that Gate 1 is sometimes unavailable to you, based on on-track activities.

You should plan to arrive at the track early on **Sunday, May 17** to enjoy as much of the **NASCAR All-Star Race** experience as possible. Here is a rundown of important times and events to remember on **Sunday, May 17**:

8 a.m.	Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials office open
9 a.m.	Infield access availability via Gate 12 begins (due to on-track activity)
9:30 a.m.	Access to the NASCAR Cup Series garage access begins
10 a.m.	Infield access availability via Gate 1 begins
10 a.m.	Access to the lane behind pit road is available
10 a.m.	Pre-Race Track Pass access available (frontstretch of track)
10:30 a.m.	Guided Garage Tour (meet in Victory Lane)
11:35 a.m.	UFP guests should be seated in The Driver's Meeting
11:45 p.m.	The Driver's Meeting begins
12:15 p.m.	NASCAR Cup Series Driver Introductions
1 p.m.	NASCAR All-Star Race begins
1 p.m.	NASCAR Cup Series garage access ends

All times above are subject to change.

Please note that ADA access is only available via Gate 1 when the track gates are open. The gates will close during any on-track activity.

TRACK TOUR

You will meet your tour guide in **Victory Lane** at **10:30 a.m.** for a guided tour of The Monster Mile. This experience includes a behind-the-scenes look at race day morning, with access to areas such as the NASCAR Cup Series garage and pit road.

WHAT CAN I CARRY IN?

Coolers and alcoholic beverages may not be carried into the infield. One small bag/purse is allowed and is subject to search.

Because you'll be doing a good amount of walking, we'd suggest you take the "less is more" approach and travel lightly.

WHAT IS THE DRIVER'S MEETING?

The Driver's Meeting is a mandatory meeting that is attended by every NASCAR Cup Series driver and crew chief, along with NASCAR officials, team owners, track officials, dignitaries, celebrities and special guests. The meeting is led by senior NASCAR officials and provides competitors with a rundown of procedures and protocol before the race begins.

ETIQUETTE

While you will be just feet away from the superstars of NASCAR, and perhaps your favorite driver, we ask that you remain respectful of their space and the objective of the meeting. While you may have the chance for an autograph prior to the meeting, as the drivers enter the tent, we can't guarantee any interaction with the competitors that morning. They are, after all, preparing themselves mentally for one of NASCAR's biggest events

less than an hour later. We reserve the right to remove you from the infield if we deem your behavior inappropriate.

MAP

A map that illustrates the location of the Ticket Services pickup location off of Rt. 13, Gate 12, Gate 1 and The Driver's Meeting is available to you. Keep it with you as a helpful reference.

GARAGE & PIT ROAD PASS

Your Ultimate Fan Pass includes a NASCAR-issued **Garage & Pit Road pass**, which provides you with access to the walking lane behind pit road and the garage areas during designated times. Please review the **Garage & Pit Road Pass** information document, available separately, for more information on the areas you can access and timing.

INFIELD EXIT

Access to the NASCAR Cup Series garage ends at the start of the race, but the access the Ultimate Fan Pass provides you inside the oval ends at the completion of the NASCAR All-Star Race.

WEATHER & OTHER ITEMS

Coordinating an event at a venue of our size requires the ability to plan for the best-case scenarios, while being ready for the unpredictable. Weather is always a variable that we can't control, and when it happens, it can throw a wrench into the best laid plans. Visit DoverMotorSpeedway.com for updates.
