Dover's Pre-Race Track Pass provides an exclusive opportunity for fans to get an up-close-and-personal look at driver introductions and red-carpet access on **Sunday, July 20** before the start of the Autotrader EchoPark Automotive 400 NASCAR Cup Series race. See the following helpful tips to make the most of your infield access pass:

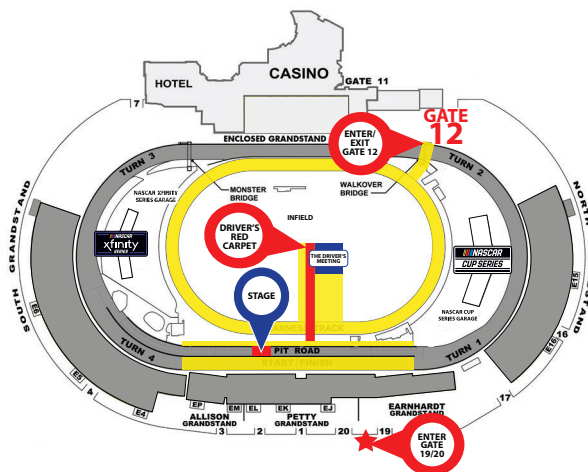
- **BASICS:** The Pre-Race Track Pass provides access on Sunday, July 20 from 10:30 a.m. until the end of driver introductions around 1:45 p.m. A grandstand ticket is required to purchase the Pre-Race Track Pass.
- **WRISTBANDS:** Can be picked up at the **GATE 19/20 TICKET SERVICES** location during the following hours:
  - **Friday, July 18:** 9 a.m.-6 p.m.
  - **Saturday, July 19:** 8 a.m.-6 p.m.
  - **Sunday, July 20:** 8 a.m.-Noon
- **ENTER:** Via Gate 19/20 or Gate 12 (Turn 2 Walkover Bridge)
- **FRONTSTRETCH ACCESS STAGE:** Driver appearances and a photo opportunity with the Monster Trophy available from **10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** on **Sunday, July 20**. Frontstretch Access lets fans walk on the concrete racing surface, experience the frontstretch's 9 degrees of banking, sign the start-finish line and watch as teams roll their cars to pit road.

- **RED CARPET ACCESS:** As drivers leave the Driver's Meeting in the ARCA Menards Series Garage they will travel on the red carpet to the pre-race stage on **Sunday, July 20 at 1:20 p.m.** Don't miss this chance to capture photos and see America's best drivers up close.
- **PRE-RACE STAGE:** Once drivers head past you to the pre-race stage, you'll want to head that way to get a good spot in the dedicated viewing area. From there, enjoy the early pre-race ceremonies.
- **EXIT TRACK:** You'll be asked to clear the track right after driver introductions finish (approximately 1:45 p.m.) to head to your seats for the green flag.

Please review some tips and key points below to help make your experience as smooth as possible.

### WRISTBAND INFO

- Enclosed are your Pre-Race Track Passes, valid on Sunday, July 20 only.
- One wristband for one person; wristband must be affixed to your wrist.
  - Do not tighten all the way - leave a gap for a comfortable fit.
- Wristbands must be accompanied by a valid race-day ticket for access.
- **Wristbands cannot be replaced if lost; DO NOT AFFIX ON WRIST UNTIL SUNDAY, JULY 20.**

### PROPERTY ENHANCEMENTS

Our improved and streamlined security screening and gate admission process is returning this summer. Please see reminders on the entry process below and be sure to visit [DoverMotorSpeedway.com](http://DoverMotorSpeedway.com) for the latest information and details.

#### • Security Screening Perimeter

- There are eight perimeter security gates on the edge of the property, including outside popular locations such as the Fan Zone and the Monster Monument at Victory Plaza.
- You will NOT have to display your ticket at these locations.

#### • Admission Scanning Gates

- Gates 1, 2, 3 and 19/20 have been extended away from the grandstands to create a fan-friendly concourse area.
- More lanes and more staff will be available to scan mobile tickets.
- Daily hand stamps will allow you to go outside the gates and return to your seat easily.
