Congratulations on your purchase of the **Ultimate Fan Pass** at Dover Motor Speedway! We look forward to seeing you soon for this exclusive behind-the-scenes opportunity as part of the **Autotrader EchoPark Automotive 400 Weekend** on **July 18-20**.

We've got a lot to explain to you, and we want to make sure you have all the information you need to ensure your Monster Mile experience is a memorable one.

PICKUP LOCATION AND TIMES

Everything you'll need for your Ultimate Fan Pass experience will be available for pickup at the **Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials Office**, located just off the Speedway's main entrance, all weekend at the following times:

- **Monday, July 14-Thursday, July 17:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Friday, July 18:** 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Saturday, July 19:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Sunday, July 20:** 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

When you arrive, you'll receive:

- Your UFP credential with Dover lanyard
- Your Garage & Pit Road pass
- YETI Rambler 30-ounce tumbler with etched track logo

GETTING AROUND & SCHEDULE

Because you already have your tickets to the race on your mobile phone, you will park wherever you choose (\$20 fee on-site) and head to the track. If you've been to a NASCAR event you know that these large venues require a good amount of walking. We encourage you to wear comfortable shoes, layer your clothes in case you get hot or cold, bring sunscreen and make sure there is plenty of space available on your phone for photos!

You can always enter and exit the track via Gate 12, outside of Turn 2 of the Speedway, by walking over the pedestrian crossover bridge. (Note that the Gate 12 entrance requires you to climb stairs to get inside the track). That said, if your seats or parking are located on the other side of the property, it might be preferable to use the Gate 1 entrance in the morning. Just know that Gate 1 is sometimes unavailable to you, based on on-track activities.

You should plan to arrive at the track early on **Sunday, July 20** to enjoy as much of the **Autotrader EchoPark Automotive 400** NASCAR Cup Series race experience as possible. Here is a rundown of important times and events to remember on **Sunday, July 20**:

8 a.m.	Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials office open
9 a.m.	Infield access availability via Gate 12 begins (due to on-track activity)
9:45 a.m.	Infield access availability via Gate 1 begins
10 a.m.	Access to the lane behind pit road begins
10:30 a.m.	Meet & greet with Mike Tatroian, DMS president and GM, in Victory Lane
11 a.m.	Access to the NASCAR Cup Series garage begins
1 p.m.	UFP guests must be seated in The Driver's Meeting
1:10 p.m.	The Driver's Meeting begins
1:30 p.m.	Driver Introductions on pre-race stage begins
2 p.m.	Start of the Autotrader EchoPark Automotive 400 NASCAR Cup Series race
5 p.m.	Approximate end of race, access to the NASCAR Cup Series garage ends

All times above are subject to change.

Please note that ADA access is only available via **Gate 1** when the track gates are open. The gates will close during any on-track activity.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Included with this letter is a document describing Dover Motor Speedway's entry procedures this year, including separate areas for security screening and admission to the grandstand/suite areas. Keep it with you as a helpful reference.

WHAT CAN I CARRY IN?

Coolers and alcoholic beverages may not be carried into the infield. One small bag/purse is allowed and is subject to search.

Because you'll be doing a good amount of walking, we'd suggest you take the "less is more" approach and travel lightly.

WHAT IS THE DRIVER'S MEETING?

The Driver's Meeting is a mandatory meeting that is attended by every NASCAR Cup Series driver and crew chief, along with NASCAR officials, team owners, track officials, dignitaries, and special guests. The meeting is led by senior NASCAR officials and provides competitors with a rundown of procedures and protocol before the race begins.

ETIQUETTE

While you will be just feet away from the sport's biggest names, and perhaps your favorite driver of all time, we ask that you remain respectful of their space and the objective of the meeting. While you may have the chance for an autograph prior to the meeting, as the drivers enter the tent, we can't guarantee any interaction with the competitors that morning. They are, after all, preparing themselves mentally for a 400-mile race less than an hour later. We reserve the right to remove you from the infield if we deem your behavior inappropriate.

MAP

A map that illustrates the location of the **Rt. 13 Ticket Services & Credentials office**, **Gate 12**, **Gate 1** and **The Driver's Meeting** is included with this letter. Keep it with you as a helpful reference.

VIP PASS

Your Ultimate Fan Pass includes a NASCAR-issued **Garage & Pit Road pass**, which provides you with access to the walking lane behind pit road and the garage areas during designated times. Please review the **Garage & Pit Road pass** information document, attached separately, for more information on the areas you can access and timing.

YETI RAMBLER 30-OUNCE TUMBLER

Your Ultimate Fan Pass includes a keepsake **YETI Rambler 30-ounce tumbler**. One tumbler is included per UFP purchased.

EXITING THE INFIELD

Ultimate Fan Pass access ends at the completion of the **Autotrader EchoPark Automotive 400 NASCAR Cup Series race**. On **Sunday, July 20**, **Gate 1** or **Gate 12** can be used to exit the infield before driver introductions are complete. When activity is on the track, the exit from the infield is via **Gate 12**.

WEATHER & OTHER ITEMS

Coordinating an event at a venue of our size requires the ability to plan for the best-case scenarios, while being ready for the unpredictable. Weather is always a variable that we can't control, and when it happens, it can throw a wrench into the best laid plans. Visit **DoverMotorSpeedway.com** for updates.
